## New Thursday Bible Study at TPC

A new year, and we are almost finished with our overview of the Bible courtesy of the Bible Project. On March 6th we will begin a new series that I was able to experience at Calvin Presbyterian in Shoreline, WA about 15 years ago.

It's called simply "**The Story**", by Randy Frazee and Tom Anthony. Forward by Max Lucado.

**The Story is an abridged, chronological Bible that reads like a novel.** Though there is material left out for the sake of the study, there is nothing added that isn't Scripture. The Story is all about the story of the Bible, God's great love affair with humanity. Using the clear, accessible text of the NIV Bible, it allows the stories, poems, and teachings of the Bible to read like a novel. And like any good story, The Story is filled with intrigue, drama, conflict, romance, and redemption; and this story's true! There are no verse references, and Scripture segments are seamlessly woven together with transition text into a single grand narrative. *Continued page 2.*

Each story in these 31 chapters reveals the God of grace—the God who speaks; the God who acts; the God who listens; the God whose love for his people culminated in his sacrifice of Jesus, his only Son, to atone for the sins of humanity. For those intimidated or overwhelmed by the unabridged Bible, *The Story* helps people understand God’s Word more fully and engage with it more easily. Simple, accessible, and easy to use, many churches have found *The Story* to be a powerful way to engage their people in Bible reading like never before. It brings the Bible to life, helping us to be swept up in the story of God’s love and his plan for our lives.

Each of our sessions will be comprised of a short video, followed by a discussion based on the reading from the book and following a study guide. ***The book and study guide will be provided from the church for all participants.***



**This should be an exciting study**, especially following up on our experience with the Bible Project videos and discussion. The caveat is that there will be a bit of **HOMEWORK** for this study, as I will ask everyone to **READ the chapter before coming** to our discussions ahead of time. You will also be able to glance through the study guide for the given lesson to familiarize yourself with what we will be discussing.

I am excited for this, and am grateful to Chris Anderson for suggesting it. After we complete *The Story*, everyone involved should be able to have a grasp of the great, over-arching story of God’s plan for salvation from Genesis through the life of Paul. I’m excited for us to begin, so I hope this gets your Bible study braincells salivating!

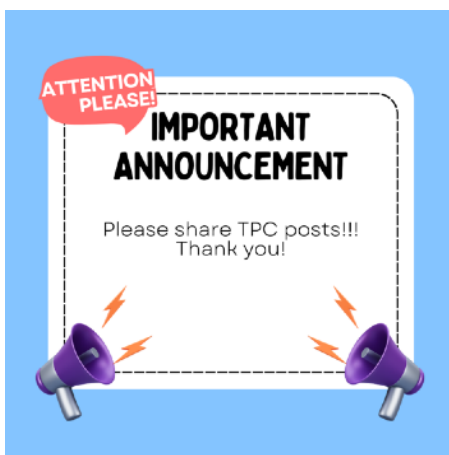

## Treasurer's Report for January 2025

In this report we'll look at general topics concerning the financial resources of the church. You'll find rows and columns of numbers on the financial reports in the elevator lobby. We have numerous bank accounts, certificates of deposit with the local bank and also with the Mission Development Certificate Program and an endowment fund with New Covenant Mutual Funds. One of the bank accounts is a Memorial Fund with no restrictions (meaning we can use it as Session sees fit).

One more thing.  
Per capita is the same as last year, \$50.

Without going into detail, we have enough assets to take care of business for a couple years. That's not to say we can take a break from supporting the ministry of TPC. Our membership is shrinking and it's up to us that are left to keep our church solvent while we wait for God to send more people to us. January saw a small but positive net income due to some spending in "office supplies" and "evangelism/advertising". The new laptop computer that was mentioned in the last treasurer's report hasn't been put into service yet, but that's on the horizon. January is a very busy time not only for the treasurer but also for co-treasurer Rebecca.

It should be noted that the review of the books that was to take place in November or December has been put on hold due to technical and logistical issues. Stay tuned for fundraising information. It is hoped that we can set an electronic, programmable reader board on the corner of the block. That effort will begin after the bell tower project is completed. I'm looking forward to what God has in mind for us this year.
